

Log-dog Operators Manual

1. Position Log-Dog next to log. Roll log onto Log-Dog.



With the tree felled, cut the stem into the appropriate lengths to accommodate the ATV's pulling capacity. Pull the Log-Dog along side of the stem, lower the outrigger and Cant hook the cut stem up into the cradle. Attach the web strap to the underside of the up-ramp, around the stem. Take the ratchet web and attach on the opposite side up-ramp, feed the web through the ratchet assembly, tension down the stem in the cradle.

2. Strap Log onto Log-Dog.



Place the outrigger in the upright position and secure with the bungee strap. Transport the stem to where you are going to stage the wood to cut into the burnable lengths, split and stack.

3. Drive away.



The Log-Dog makes it easy to maneuver through uneven terrain and around obstacles when removing stems from the woods to where the staging and splitting takes place. In the staging area, drop the stems into position near the splitter, rolling them off the Log-Dog with the Cant hook on the side without the outrigger into a parallel row as shown in the picture.

Recommended Third Party Accessory

You will need to have a cant hook (not supplied) to maneuver the logs from the ground, up the outrigger ramp and into the cradle of the Log Dog. The cant hook will also be useful in unloading and staging logs for cutting.
